BEACHES

Dogs love to run free, and there is nothing more fun for them to run off the leash on the beach, but there are some rules and considerations that need to be taken into account



Pick up your doggy doo, no-one likes to step in it by mistake, so **always carry a packet with you** on your walks.



If the beach you go to has a sign saying "Dogs on a leash", then you need to **adhere** to that for the safety of your dog and others.



Adhere to any rules/policies that are posted on the beach with regards to dogs.



Not everyone may like fur children and the happiness or excitement can sometimes be interpreted as aggression and result in nasty situations, so **be alert and aware of your surroundings** and the people in it.



When on beaches that do allow dogs off leash, ensure you **keep your eye on your dog/s at all times** to ensure that they do not interfere with others enjoying the beach.



Make sure that your dog is **trained and understands voice commands**.

- ✚ **Glenmore Beach (3km)** – Rocky beach good for surfing & swimming, with seasonal visits from humpback whales & dolphins
No dogs allowed without leads
- ✚ **Granny Pool Beach (12km)** – Awesome beach for families with young children - **No dogs allowed on swimming beach, BUT entrance to dog beach is 250 meters south of Granny Pool Beach.**
- ✚ **Kidds Beach – Beautiful cosy little beach (7.1km)** - **No dogs allowed**
- ✚ **Marina Beach (6km)** – This ideal family-friendly coastal destination has a fantastic tidal pool which provides children and novice swimmers with a safe swimming environment. A beautiful rustic space for sunbathing, snorkelling or hunting among the rock pools. Blue Flag beach for 20 consecutive years
No dogs allowed
- ✚ **San Lameer Beach (8.3km)** – Laid-back beach featuring a wide stretch of sand with tidal pools, a café & seafood restaurant - **No dogs allowed**
- ✚ **Southbroom Main Beach (8.3km)** – Southbroom is one of the most popular unspoilt beaches on the South Coast. Lifeguards on duty during holiday seasons - **No dogs allowed**
- ✚ **Southbroom – Umkobi Beach (next to Trattoria La Terrazza Restaurant)** – **Pet-Friendly**
- ✚ **Trafalgar Beach (3.4km)** - Part of this Blue Flag beach is a Marine protected area, which welcomes snorkellers to explore the incredible fossil beds believed to be around 90 million years old. Outside of snorkelling, the warm waters are perfect for swimming, surfing and fishing. – **No dogs allowed**
- ✚ **Southport Beach (4.1km)** - This is the perfect space for swimming, snorkelling, padding and diving. There are shaded braai facilities for those wanting an open-air meal, with dolpin and whale watching a regular attraction.

- 🚦 **Leisure Crest Beach (5km)** – No word to describe this beautiful and tranquil beach. A little piece of heaven.
- 🚦 **Ivy Beach (6km)** – White sandy beach situated next to a small resort.

Beach and shoreline safety, especially but not only at spring tides

- Take care esp in the hours before, during and after high tide, when on or near to the rocks and shoreline.
- Spend time looking at and studying the sea so you have a good idea what it's doing.
- Always know if the tide is coming in or going out.
- Never turn your back on the sea.
- Always know when the next wave is coming.
- Always know when the next set of waves is coming.
- Anticipate how far the wave will wash up the beach or the rocks so that you can move to higher ground slowly and carefully _and not RUN_. That's when people can fall and get hurt.

IMPORTANT: Always, always, always keep a close eye on children when they're in the water to make sure they are in a safe zone.
Things can go bad very quickly with kids.

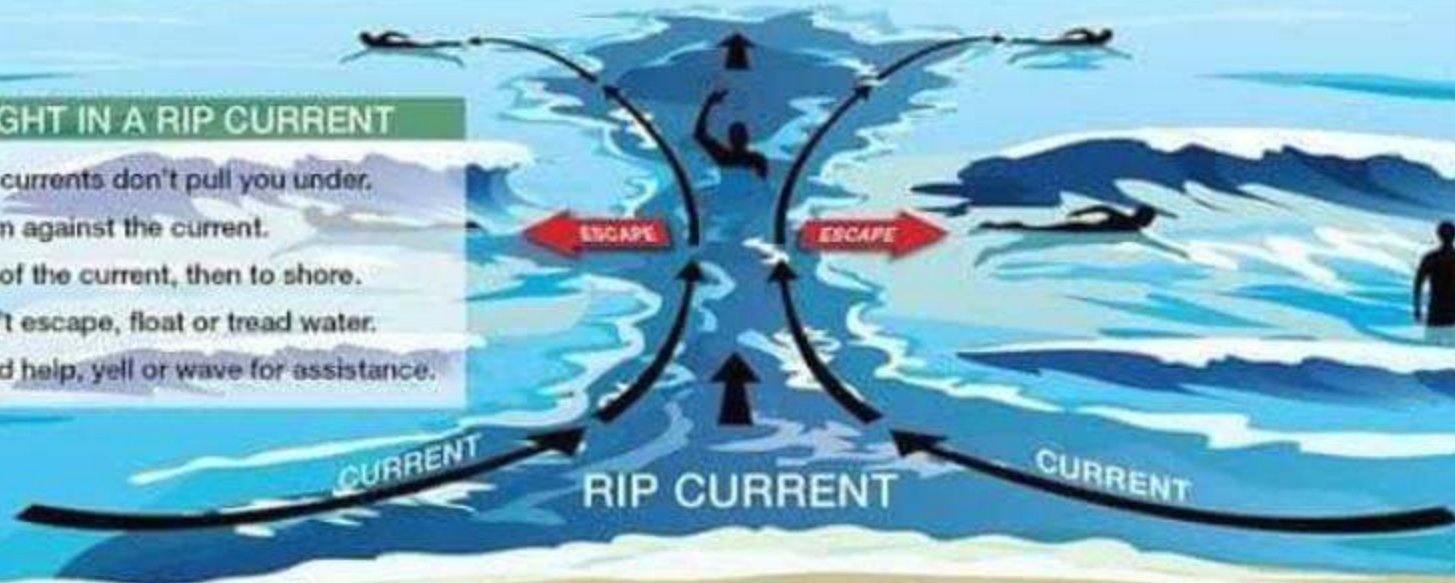


RIP CURRENTS

KNOW YOUR OPTIONS

IF CAUGHT IN A RIP CURRENT

- Relax, rip currents don't pull you under.
- Don't swim against the current.
- Swim out of the current, then to shore.
- If you can't escape, float or tread water.
- If you need help, yell or wave for assistance.



Rip currents are powerful currents of water moving away from shore. They can sweep even the strongest swimmer away from shore. If at all possible, swim near a lifeguard.



WATER SAFETY

- ✦ Always swim with a buddy; do not allow anyone to swim alone.
- ✦ Don't use alcohol or drugs (including certain prescription medications) before or while swimming or supervising swimmers.
- ✦ Provide close and constant attention to children you are supervising in or near water.
- ✦ Swim in designated areas supervised by lifeguards.
- ✦ Do not rely on the use of water wings, swim rings, inflatable toys or other items designed for water recreation to replace adult supervision.
- ✦ If you have a pool, secure it with appropriate barriers to prevent unsupervised access to the water.

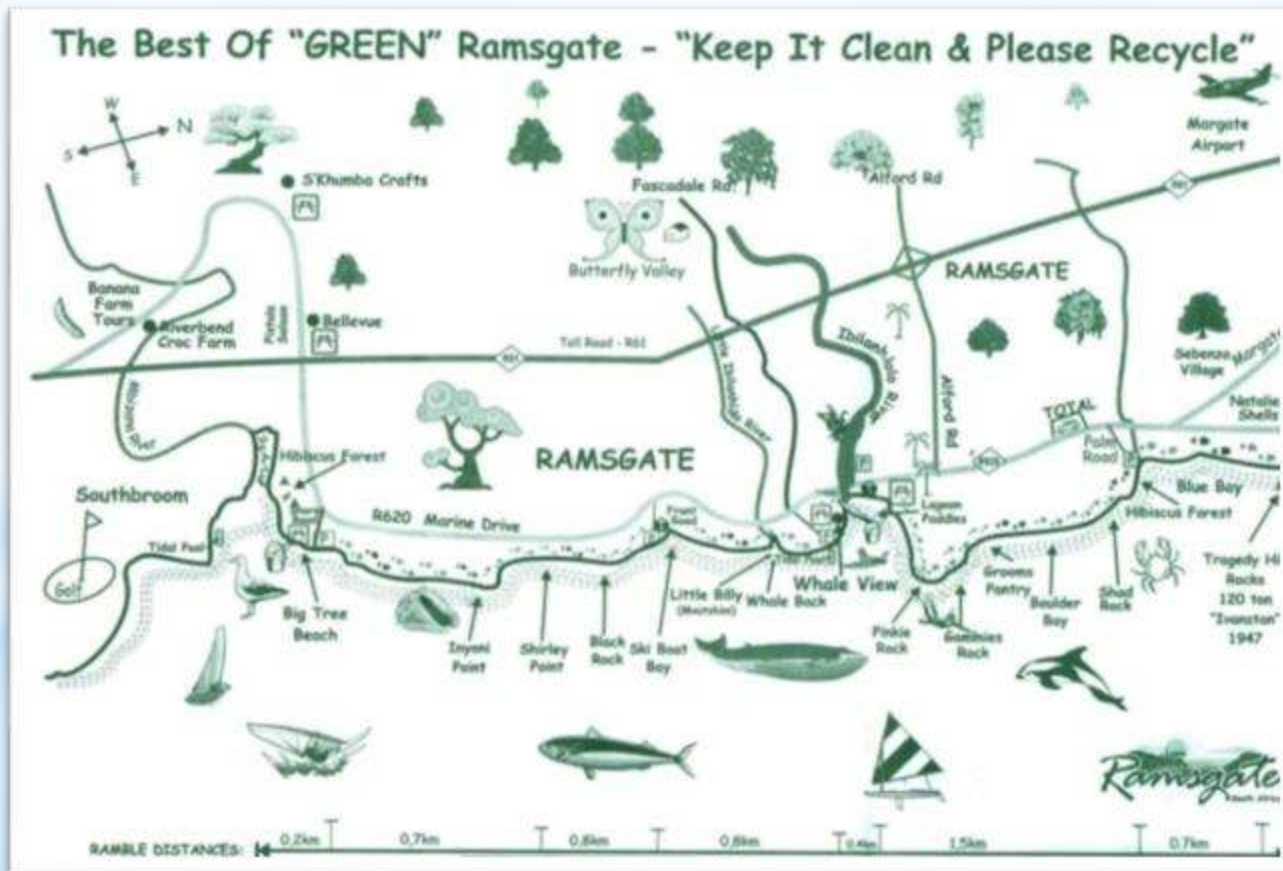

HIKING / MOUNTAIN BIKES:

Umtamvuna Nature Reserve: 12km from Palm Beach

Another great day out is this stunning coastal reserve which has several marked trails for fantastic wild- and birdlife viewing. There is even a large colony of endangered Cape vultures which can be observed in their nesting sites.

The trails vary in duration from one- to three-hour or an all-day hike. Many hours and days can be spent exploring the diverse habitats.

Both the Cape vulture and fish eagle breed in the reserve and many other bird species have been recorded. Bushbuck, Serval, baboon, Samango monkeys, blue and grey duiker and common reedbuck occur in the reserve.

Kwanzimakwe Multi-trails: Contact #: 063-072-1873

Situated between Mpenjati Nature Reserve and Ezinqoleni is the KwaNzimakwe Multi-Trails that fuses natural beauty with local cultural heritage.

The KwaNzimakwe Multi-Trails Park, gives hikers, birdwatchers and 4x4 enthusiasts the opportunity to immerse themselves in this stunning region.

HIKING / MOUNTAIN BIKES:

Beaver Creek Coffee Estate: 15km from Palm Beach

The beautiful Port Edward-based coffee estate, which is the southernmost coffee plantation in the world, is also the home of some incredible mountain biking trails. For the little ones, there is the 400m Chocochino Route around the coffee shop, then there's the 2.5km Espresso Route through the Beaver Creek coffee fields, as well as the advanced 8.5km Stoney Creek Route through Beaver Creek and surrounding farms.

Farm.Trail.Life (Old name Clearwater Trails) @ Beaver Creek : 15km from Palm Beach

Located just outside of Southbroom on the KZN South Coast, along the banks of Mtamvuna River and meandering through Beaver Creek Coffee Estate and Craggs View Wild Care Centre is Clearwater Trails. Most of the trails include stunning views of the Indian Ocean, with Mtamvuna River gorge visible from the Gorge View Deck. For MBT they open @ 08:00 in the morning. Cost R40-00 pp (Rates subject to change)

Seaview: 3km from Palm Beach

Both a mountain bike, trail running & hiking track will lead you into the heart of the farm where you can enjoy the silent tranquillity of nature, whilst also getting up close and personal with the game. The 6, 8, 10 & 16km trails are well marked. And for the less active, these trails can also be walked at leisure.
